- Forgery of 108 (cobalt blue)
- Forgery of 108 (cobalt blue) w. double impression
- Forgery of 109 (maize yellow)
- Forgery of a 8 sk stamp (emerald green)
- Forgery of a 8 sk stamp (light green)

Accidentally, this set was all but lost on the day of issue. Just very few stamps were actually issued (12 single stamps in all). The genuine stamps can easily be distinguished from the forgeries, as they use another number type and a slightly larger frame.
