

1964 School Ship Løvejagten, perf. 10.5 v

Access to the school ship Løvejagten for one year could be obtained by purchasing a recruitment book stamp for 2 Danish kroner, which was stuck into the personal recruitment book of the citizen and then usually date-cancelled.

The 5 kroner value included a voluntary donation.

Use of the recruitment book continued after the ship was sold in 1974, in a function as a passport or identity card. Other postage stamps were also used for the book later.

Recruitment books remained in use as a kind of replacement passport document after the school ship was sold in 1974.
